Richmond -- Congressman Mark DeSaulnier (CA-11) announced he will be opening his Richmond Congressional district office at the City's Civic Center, located at 440 Civic Center Plaza, 2nd Floor on January 6th, 2015.

"We are pleased the Richmond district office is centrally located at the Civic Center, which houses many local government resources, because it will continue our work to make government as accessible as possible for area residents. We are grateful for the Richmond City Council's assistance with this endeavor," said Mark DeSaulnier.

Congressman-elect DeSaulnier's office will assist constituents who need help with a federal agency, passport application, are applying to a military academy, requesting a tour of the White House or United States Capitol, a Presidential greeting, Congressional commendations or wish to have a flag flown over the United States Capitol. Several full-time Congressional staff will also be based out of the location, working with local and regional governments to advocate on their behalf in Washington.

We are happy to be back working in West County. The staff and I look forward to assisting you," concluded DeSaulnier.
